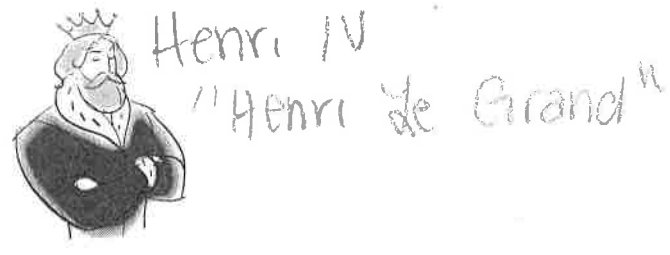

• Promised "chicken in every pot"

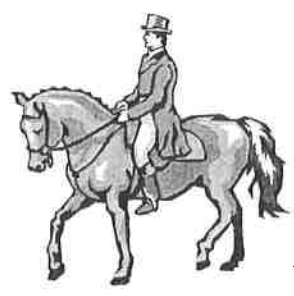
• Named him "Henri le Grand"

Granted them liberty of conscience and liberty of public worship. in 150 fortified towns (like La Rochelle)



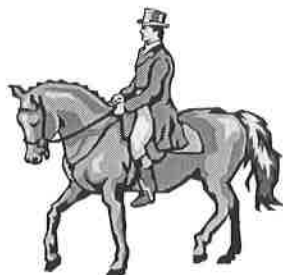
Merchants

Louis XIII



Catholic Church

- Cardinal Richelieu and Louis XIII focused on the destruction of Habsburg territory, Richelieu created a French Foreign Policy



Huguenots

- Believed Huguenots to have political disobedience because they wanted freedom of conscience but would not allow Catholics to worship in their cities, enacted Protestant military and political independence



Merchants

- Merchants were just chillin



Peasants

- Protested against him due to unemployment, high food prices, grain shortages, new taxes, and oppressive taxation, led to domestic violence



Nobles

- Disliked Louis XIII because he increased his monarch power.

Catholic Church

- Revoked the Edict of Nantes,
- Stopped Protestants.
- Made Catholics happy.

Huguenots

- Revoked the Edict of Nantes
- New law ordered destruction of churches, closing of schools, exile of priests, etc.
- Not happy.



Merchants

- Colbert helped the cloth industry, developed manufacturing, prosperity of commercial classes.
- Suffered during the wars, resources wasted, economy suffered.
- Happy and not happy.



Peasants

- Economy rested on agriculture.
- Poor harvests, taxes, etc. caused them to leave.
- Economy hurt.
- Not happy.



Nobles

- Sometimes not happy,
- Happy at first because agreement said they couldn't be taxed
- Later he and Cardinal Richelieu tried to decrease the power of the nobility/tax them
