There will be some passages with questions over them, in particular these:

When is it appropriate to use semicolons, commas, and apostrophes?

Who are the authors, what were the occasions, and what are the major ideas in the 4 speeches listed above?

These questions might be multiple choice or matching asking you to define the terms or recognize them as others have used them. I may also give you a prompt and ask you to write a paragraph using these techniques, so really know them.
