Balfour Declaration

- “The Balfour Declaration was a November 2, 1917 letter from British Foreign Secretary Arthur James Balfour to Lord Rothschild that made public the British support of a Jewish homeland in Palestine. The Balfour Declaration led the League of Nations to entrust the [United Kingdom](#) with the Palestine Mandate in 1922.” (Rosenberg)
- Nothing happened with this until after World War II with the creation of Israel in 1948.
